

Safety Travel Checklist

- Check www.fco.gov.uk/travel for the country you are visiting.
- Check the entry requirements, local customs and rules of the country you plan on visiting.
- Check with your doctor to find out if you need any vaccinations before you travel.
- Make sure that your passport is valid.
Make sure you've got correct visas for the country you are visiting.
- Make sure your licence is current and valid if you plan on driving.
- Make sure you are aware of the driving laws in the country you are visiting.
- Get a free EHIC for free or reduced emergency care.
- Take out appropriate travel insurance and make sure it covers you for any activities you are likely to undertake.
- Make sure you have enough money to cover emergencies.
- Make a note of the passport number and consider taking a photocopy with you or store online using a secure data storage site
- Make sure you fill in the emergency contact details in your passport.
- Tell family and friends where you are going and leave them your contact details, travel insurance details and your itinerary.
